CYBER Security: The Internet of Things 4 tips to keep yourself safe digitally

1. **Disconnect when not in use.** This may not always be available, but disconnecting prevents access to your information. Also, this allows you a chance to relax without the pressures of the internet and the actions that occur there.
2. **Avoid connecting to unknown devices.** This may seem a little obvious, but rental cars, public Wi-Fi hotspots, and any other devices that you can connect to, you might want to think twice... Some of these devices may store information from your device or they may open your device to being seen by others on a network that you may not know, or want to be seen by.
3. **Limit the connections you allow.** For this tip, you may want to be selective about what devices you purchase. As an extreme example, do we really need fridges that connect to the internet? Do we need the latest gadgets and technology? Sometimes being on the



cutting edge of technology is necessary, other times being a little behind is the best place to be.

4. **Clean your device regularly.** This means running anti-virus software and being aware of the files that you have on your device. You may want to consider backing up your data to either a cloud-based storage or to a removable hard drive. This will allow you to have a more organized device as well.
